Topic - *The Ancient Greeks*

<b>SUBJECT</b>	<b>DETAILS</b>
<b>ENGLISH</b>	Revision for SATs: grammar, reading skills, spelling rules. Transition unit of work based on 'Kensuke's Kingdom' book: diary writing, narrative and descriptions. Non-chronological reports based on Ancient Greeks topic work
<b>MATHS</b>	Revision for SATs tests in May, application of real life problems including data handling, ratio and algebra, shape, space and measures
<b>HISTORY</b>	Ancient Greece :A Study of the difference between life as an Athenian or Spartan, & debates as to the benefits & drawback of each lifestyle, and how Ancient Greece has impacted on life today (arts, architecture)
<b>GEOGRAPHY</b>	'Raging Rivers' topic studying river characteristics, flow, and erosion
<b>FRENCH</b>	Conversational French, items of clothing, colours and looking at which countries speak French 'Le Cirque'.
<b>ART</b>	A study of ancient Greek art - shapes and colours of pots, designing and creating pots out of clay, using wax and ink
<b>SCIENCE</b>	Light - how light is reflected and refracted Electricity - building and repairing circuits, using renewable energy
<b>DESIGN &amp; TECHNOLOGY</b>	Using mechanisms , including pneumatics to design a moving light up Greek monster
<b>COMPUTING</b>	Website Design, Film-Making and using KODU
<b>PHYSICAL EDUCATION</b>	Athletics and Rounders
<b>RELIGIOUS EDUCATION</b>	Prayer and worship in Sikhism
<b>MUSIC</b>	Develop music based on the song 'You've Got A Friend' (voice and percussion) and study its rhythm and pitch and prepare for end of year performance
<b>PSHE</b>	Healthy, Happy, Me- including Sex Education and The Great Project.
