# Where are we going?

We are staying at Ilam Hall in Ashbourne, Derbyshire.

Our activities are all provided by an onsite team who are skilled and trained in the relevant areas and activities.

Some activities are in the grounds of Ilam Hall and some are off site at Black Rocks (Matlock) where we will make use of the onsite transport.

# Activities

We will return to school on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> April, getting back to school for around 3pm.
